Communication and Language

PSED

- -I am independent and assess my own opportunities.
- -I include everyone and I am thoughtful of others feelings.
- I know what is important to me, my family and what makes me unique.
 - Shows their growing sense of self through asserting their likes and dislikes, choices, decisions and ideas. (Range 3)
 - Enjoys playing alone and alongside others and is also interested in being together and playing with other children (Range 3)
 - Expresses positive feelings such as joy and affection and negative feelings such as anger, frustration and distress, through actions, behaviours and a few words. (Range 3)

Physical Development

- -I can use my body in a range of ways.
- -I am responsible and independent with my own self-care.
 - Hands start to operate independently during a task that uses both, with each hand doing something different at the same time (E.g. Holding a block in one hand and steadying a block in the other hand.) (Range 3)
 - Can walk considerable distance with purpose, stopping, starting and changing direction.
 (Range 3)
 - Helps with dressing/undressing and care routines, enjoying the rituals established for hand washing and teeth cleaning. (Range 3)
 - Feeds self with increasing need to be in control and holds cup with both hands, drinking without much spilling. (Range 3)

Literacy

- -I embrace and explore real life experiences.
- -I enjoy listening, reading and retelling favourite stories, songs and rhymes.
 - Is interested in and anticipates books and rhymes and may have favourites. (Range 3)
