Communication and Language

- -I can confidently communicate my needs, thoughts and ideas.
- I show appreciation for the voice of others.
 - Holds a conversation, jumping from topic to topic (Range 4)
 - Listens to others, one-to-one or in small groups when conversation interests them (Range 5)
 - Understands 'Who, What, Where' in simple questions (Range 4)

PSED

- -I am independent and assess my own opportunities.
- -I include everyone and I am thoughtful of others feelings.
- I know what is important to me, my family and what makes me unique.
 - Shows a sense of autonomy through asserting their preferences and making choices and decisions (Range 4)
 - Shows empathy and concern for people who are special to them (Range 4)
 - Seeks out others to share experiences (Range 4)
 - Responds to the feelings of others, showing concern and offering comfort. (Range 4)

Physical Development

- -I can use my body in a range of ways.
- -I am responsible and independent with my own self-care.
 - Shows increasing control in holding, using and manipulating a range of tools and objects such as tambourines, hammers and mark making tools. (Range 4)
 - May be beginning to show preference for dominant hand and/or leg/foot. (Range 4)
 - Begins to walk/run and climb on different levels and surfaces (Range 4)
 - Feeds self competently (Range 4)
 - Able to help with and increasingly independently put on and take off simple clothing items such as hats, unzipped jackets, wellington boots. (Range 4)

Literacy

- -I embrace and explore real life experiences.
- -I enjoy listening, reading and retelling favourite stories, songs and rhymes.
 - Listens to and joins in with stories and poems when reading one-to-one and in small groups. (Range 5)
 - Distinguishes between the different marks they make (Range 4)

Mathematics

- -I embrace a love for numbers, learning with open ended resources.
 - Begins to say numbers in order, some of which are in the right order (Range 4)
 - Is interested in what happens next using the patterns of everyday routines (Range 4)
 - Moves their bodies and toys around objects and explores fitting into spaces (Range 4)

Understanding the World

- -I join in and embrace other cultures and beliefs.
- -I understand growth, change and the effects on the environment
 - Learns that they have similarities and differences that connect them to and distinguishes them from, others. (Range 4)
 - Can talk about some of the things they have observed such as plants, animals, natural and found objects. (Range 4)
 - Plays with water to investigate 'low technology' such as washing and cleaning. (Range 4)

Expressive Arts and Design

- -I express myself through a range of media.
- -I engage independently in imaginative play in a range of contexts
 - Enjoys and responds to playing with colour in a variety of ways, for example combining colours. (Range 4)
 - Begins to make believe by pretending, using sounds, movement, words, objects. Beginning to describe sounds imaginatively, e.g. scary music. (Range 4)
